NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR HOMOEOPATHY

Notification

GSR No	In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and clauses (zf), (zg), (zh), (zi)
and (zj) of sub-	section (2) of section 55 read with sections 32, 33 and 34 of the National Commission for
Homoeopathy	Act, 2020 (15 of 2020), the National Commission for Homocopathy hereby makes the
following regul	ations further to amend the National Commission for Homeopathy (Manner of Preparation
and Maintenand	ee of National Register for Practitioner of Homocopathy) Regulations, 2022, namely:-

- (i) These regulations may be called the National Commission for Homeopathy (Manner of Preparation and Maintenance of National Register for Practitioner of Homocopathy) Amendment Regulations, 2024.
 - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in Official Gazette.
 - 2. In Regulation 3 of the said Regulations:
 - i. in clause (3) for the word "two copies" the word "one copy" shall be substituted;
 - ii. in clause (4) for the word "one year" the word "three year" shall be substituted.
 - 3. In regulation 3 of the said Regulations, after sub-regulation (7), the following sub-regulation shall be inserted, namely: -
 - "(8) A qualified licensed practitioner of Homocopathy with 03 years of administrative experience with desirable qualification of post-graduation in Homocopathy and having knowledge of medical ethics, shall be appointed as Registrar."
 - 4. In regulation 4 of the said Regulations, sub-regulation (1), shall be substituted by :-
 - (1) Any person possessing medical qualification in Homocopathy recognised by the Homocopathy Education Board or recognised under the Second or Third schedule to the *erstwhile* Homocopathy Central Council Act, 1973 (59 of 1973), shall be eligible to obtain license to practice Homocopathy, from the concerned State Medical Council for Homocopathy, where he resides but only after qualifying the National Exit Test to be conducted under regulation 13 of National Commission for Homocopathy (National Examinations in Homocopathy) Regulations, 2023.
 - 5. In regulation 6 of the said Regulations, the 1st para shall be substituted by : -

Registration with National Commission for Homoeopathy. — Where the State Medical Council for Homoeopathy is not constituted, the National Commission for Homoeopathy through the Board of Ethics and Registration for Homoeopathy, shall register a medical practitioner of Homoeopathy residing in that State or Union territory and who qualifies the National Exit Test held under regulation 13 of National Commission for Homoeopathy (National Examinations in Homoeopathy) Regulations, 2023, and on submission of application form along with fee as specified under these Regulations.

- 6. In regulation 7 of the said Regulations, sub-regulation (1) and (3) shall be substituted by : -
 - (1) Any foreign citizen possessing the recognized medical qualification in Homocopathy of his country and that practitioner is registered in that country and his qualification is recognised by the National Commission for Homocopathy and desires license to practice Homocopathy in India, shall be required to obtain diplomatic permission for stay in India and shall be eligible for obtaining temporary license for the period of falling within the such permitted stay but not exceeding six months at a time, and only after qualifying the National Examinations in Homocopathy) Regulations, 2023.

Provided that in case of a foreign citizen who desires to pursue any additional qualification in Homoeopathy in India recognised by the National Commission for Homoeopathy, shall be eligible for obtaining the license for the period of his study but only after qualifying the National Exit Test held under regulation 13 of National Commission for Homoeopathy (National Examinations in Homoeopathy) Regulations, 2023.

- (3) Any person who is citizen of India and holding foreign qualification recognised by the National Commission for Homoeopathy and desires for the License to practice Homoeopathy, shall have to qualify the National Exit Test held under regulation 13 of National Commission for Homoeopathy (National Examinations in Homoeopathy) Regulations, 2023, and shall apply to the concerned State Medical Council for Homoeopathy.
- 7. In regulation 9 of the said Regulations, after sub-regulation (1), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely: -

"Provided that no such updatation / renewal shall be allowed if practitioner fails to attend 02 CMEs (Continuing Medical Education) within 5 years, conducted by State Medical Council for Homocopathy or authorized institutions or agencies for the purpose of CME, on the basis of guidelines framed by the BERH / NCH."

8. In regulation 9 of the said Regulations under sub-regulation (2) the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

"Provided further that such fresh application for license shall be considered only if practitioner qualifies the National Exit Test held under regulation 13 of National Commission for Homocopathy (National Examinations in Homocopathy) Regulations, 2023."
