

File No. 3-41/2022/NCH/HEB/Regulation-DRL-In exercise of the powers conferred upon by section 55, and read with section 35, 36, 37 & 38 of The National Commission for Homoeopathy, Act 2020 (15 of 2020), the National Commission for Homoeopathy hereby makes the following regulations, namely:

1. Short title and commencement:

- i. These regulations may be called - ***National Commission for Homoeopathy (Recognition of Qualifications of Homoeopathy) Regulations 2022.***
- ii. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions:

In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) "Act" means the National Commission for Homoeopathy, 2020 (15 of 2020);
- (b) "Commission" means the National Commission for Homoeopathy constituted under section 3 of NCH Act 2020 hereby mentioned as NCH;
- (c) "Medical institution" means any institution within or outside India which, grants degrees, diplomas or licences in Homoeopathy and includes affiliated colleges, universities and deemed to be universities as defined under clause (j) of section 2 of NCH Act 2020;
- (d) "University" shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in clause (f) of section 2 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and includes a health university;
- (e) "Homoeopathy Education Board" hereby mentioned as HEB means the Board constituted for Homoeopathy education under section 18;
- (f) "Homoeopathy" means the Homoeopathic System of Medicine and includes the use of biochemic remedies supplemented by such modern advances, scientific and technological development as the Commission may, in consultation with the Central Government, declare by notification from time to time as defined under clause (f) of section 2 of NCH Act 2020;
- (g) "Degree / Medical Qualification means" degree in Homoeopathy as defined in regulation 3 of Homoeopathy (Degree Course) regulation 1983; regulation 3(2) of Homoeopathy (Post-graduate degree course) regulation 1989 and any such degree/diploma/certificate notified by NCH from time to time;
- (h) "Degree Recognition List" hereby mentioned as DRL, means list

maintained by Homoeopathy Education Board after granting/denying recognition to the medical qualification in Homoeopathy at Undergraduate & Postgraduate level provided by any university as per section 35, 36, 37 & 38 of NCH Act 2020;

- (i) "Appendix" means an appendix appended to these regulations;
- (j) "Courses" means the course of study in Homoeopathy, namely:-
 - (I) "degree" means a Degree in Homoeopathy as defined erstwhile in clause (iv) of regulation 2 of the Homoeopathy (Graded Degree Course) Regulations, 1983 or in clause (iv) of regulations 2 of the Homoeopathy (Degree Course) Regulations, 1983;
 - (II) B.H.M.S. means a Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery Undergraduate qualification in Homoeopathy recognised as per the provisions of the Act;
 - (III) "M.D (Homoeopathy)/Post Graduation in Homoeopathy" means a Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy recognised as per the provisions of the Act.
- (k) Words or expressions used in these regulations and not defined herein but defined in the Act shall have respective meaning assigned to them in the Act.

3. Aims and objectives: Granting recognition (inclusion as well as withdrawal) to medical qualifications (Undergraduate degree, Postgraduate degree, Post Graduate Certificates, Post Graduate Diplomas, as notified by NCH from time to time) at all levels which relate to Homoeopathy.

4. Recognition of Qualifications Granted by Universities or Medical Institutions in India (Section-35): Medical qualifications/degrees as specified (**Appendix-I**) in these regulations granted by universities or medical institutions in India shall be granted recognition by NCH under section 35, provided that those universities or medical institutions fulfill all the requisite criteria for degree recognition as specified by NCH.

Explanation:

4.1 Any university or medical institution in India which grants an undergraduate, postgraduate or super speciality qualification in Homoeopathy (as specified in clause j and s under section 2 of NCH Act 2020) duly recognized by NCH to those students who have successfully completed the stipulated duration of study, followed prescribed syllabus/curriculum and cleared all the examinations as defined in respective regulations and completed any other requirements like compulsory rotatory internship or electives as the case may be shall apply online/offline (as specified on NCH website) through the affiliating University in prescribed application form along with necessary documents to Homoeopathy Education Board of NCH within 45 days of completion of UG internship/ PG Course .

4.2 On receipt of such application duly filled with relevant information alongwith all requisite documents, Homoeopathy Education Board shall examine the application with respect to 'implementation of syllabus/curriculum, evaluation system, nomenclature of qualification as specified by NCH and status of permission for admission into courses/programs, admission following respective regulation etc. and shall grant or deny recognition within six months from the date of receipt of application by NCH. After granting the recognition the degree provided by the university shall be included in DRL-1 as per **Appendix II**.

4.3 Procedure

- a. Upon review of application and attached documents, if any deficiency/discrepancy is observed, the Homoeopathy Education Board shall communicate the same to the applicant university. In case if the deficiencies are rectified or discrepancies are clarified, the application shall be processed further by Homoeopathy Education Board for listing of Qualification. In case of non-fulfillment of requisite information and/or non-fulfillment of criteria for grant of recognition, the application shall be rejected. Homoeopathy Education Board shall grant or deny recognition within six months from the date of receipt of application by NCH.
- b. In case of refusal of grant of recognition to a medical qualification, the aggrieved university/institution may prefer an appeal to the NCH within a period of sixty days from the date of communication of the decision of Homoeopathy Education Board.
- c. Such appeals shall be examined by NCH and may direct the board for inclusion of such medical qualifications on fulfilling the requisite criteria. Such decision of grant/denial shall be communicated within period of sixty days of receipt of appeal by the NCH.
- d. In case of refusal of grant of recognition of medical qualification by the NCH or lapse of communication by NCH within specified period of sixty days, the aggrieved university/institution may prefer second appeal to Central Government within a period of thirty days from the date of communication of such decision by NCH or in case of lapse of communication by the NCH these colleges appeal to the Central Government.
- e. Notification of recognition of qualification by NCH shall be on quarterly basis.
- f. All Homoeopathy medical qualifications which have been recognized before the date of commencement of the NCH Act 2020 and are included in the Second and Third Schedule to the CCH Act, 1973 shall also be listed and maintained by Homoeopathy Education Board.

4.4 The HEB may recommend for surprise inspections in any of the Institutions imparting undergraduate (UG) & postgraduate (PG) Homoeopathy courses as and when it deems fit to do so.

4.5 The recognition so granted to undergraduate & postgraduate qualification shall be for a period of three years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

4.6 Failure to seek timely recognition as mentioned under 4, will invite appropriate penalty as decided by NCH on case to case basis.

4.7 The requisite criteria for grant of recognition shall be as defined by NCH as below:

4.7.1 The institution through the affiliating University shall apply within 45 days of completion of UG internship / PG Course.

4.7.1.a. Documents required for undergraduate (B.H.M.S.)

- a. Details of number of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges affiliated to University, at present (and in past) (with their names & addresses and intake capacity);
- b. Details of number of admissions made in I-BHMS Degree Course of 5^{1/2} years duration under the University in its affiliated colleges showing the names of candidates, date of admission, NEET/AIAPGET score- if applicable, date of examination of BHMS (I,II,III,IV) in which they appeared & result.
- c. Details of hospital staff in Teaching Homoeopathic Hospitals attached to such college as per Homoeopathy (M.S.R.) Regulations.
- d. Details of migration of students from one college to another and vice-versa in enclosed format; and whether permission of erstwhile Council and University was taken in such cases.
- e. Detailed information regarding the appointment of subject wise & year-wise internal and external examiners and paper setters separately for the students who have been examined in BHMS Degree Course of 5^{1/2} years duration in the Proforma enclosed (college wise).
- f. Any failure student of BHMS degree, if so number thereof (college wise) and number of chances availed by them (separately) to clear successfully the said examination (with name of candidate and other details).
- g. Details of dates of starting & completion of compulsory internship training by each student who has passed BHMS examination in all subjects with name of training hospital where he or she has undergone such training (with their provisional registration given by State Council of Homoeopathy).
- h. Copy of approval of such college from Central Government for specific year.
- i. Any other relevant information.

4.7.1. b. Document required for Post Graduate (M.D-Hom)

- a. Details of name of students of M.D. (Hom.) speciality subject-wise, batch wise with PG entrance examination score-if applicable, enrolled by the colleges concerned who have been examined by the University (till date).
- b. Details of the names of Professors, Readers and Lecturers with all relevant details (qualification, year of joining, years of experience etc.) may be sent concerning speciality subjects of M.D. (Hom) Courses.
- c. Details of the names of Guide approved appointed (year wise) for M.D. (Hom) students be sent.
- d. Details of number of beds earmarked for P.G. students in IPD in Homoeopathic Hospitals of the College concerned be sent with month & year wise occupation by patients.
- e. A report on work done by PG students during house job department wise.
- f. Copy of Question Papers set by the university for M.D. (Hom) Part-I and II exams in speciality subjects concerned.
- g. Copy of University Ordinance/Regulations (duly attested by Registrar of University) be sent for M.D. (Hom) Courses.
- h. Copy of results declared of M.D. (Hom.) course in various speciality subjects (college wise, eligible batch wise).
- i. List of examiners appointed by the university for said Courses.
- j. Date Sheet of theory & practical of M.D. (Hom) exams of University be sent immediately, if any Schedule for next 60 days has been drawn.
- k. Any other relevant information.

4.8 The procedure for Renewal of recognition: The Institute through the affiliating University shall apply for renewal of recognition of Undergraduate & Postgraduate qualification in the Institution within 45 days of completion of UG internship / PG course of eligible batch.

4.8.1 At the time of renewal institute shall provide the requisite documents as mentioned in 4.7.1 (a/b) whichever applicable for eligible batch of UG /PG.

4.8.2 The procedure for renewal of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

4.9 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as mentioned under 4, will invite appropriate penalty as decided by NCH on case to case basis.

4.10 Notification of recognition of qualification by Commission shall be on quarterly basis.

5. Recognition of Qualifications Granted by Universities or Medical Institutions outside India (Section-36): Medical qualifications/degrees in these regulations granted by universities or medical institutions outside India shall be granted recognition by NCH under section 36, provided that those

universities or medical institutes fulfill all the requisite criteria for degree recognition as specified by NCH.

Explanation

5.1 An authority in any country outside India, which by the law of that country, is entrusted with the recognition of qualifications of Homoeopathy in that country, may make an application to the NCH for granting recognition to such qualifications in India. NCH on receipt of such application will seek recommendation of Homoeopathy Education Board. HEB will verify requisite details. After recommendation of HEB, Commission may grant or refuse to grant recognition to the medical qualification. After granting the recognition, NCH shall include medical qualification in DRL-2 as per **Appendix III** and shall be maintained by NCH.

5.2 Procedure

- a. Upon review of application and attached documents, if any deficiency/discrepancy is observed, the Commission shall communicate the same to the applicant university. In case if the deficiencies are rectified or discrepancies are clarified, the applications shall be processed further for listing of Qualification. In case of non-fulfilment of requisite information and/ or non-fulfilment of criteria for grant of recognition, the application shall be rejected. National Commission for Homoeopathy shall grant or deny recognition.
- b. Where the Commission grants recognition to any medical qualification under sub-section (1), such qualification shall be a recognised qualification for the purposes of NCH Act 2020 and shall be included in the list maintained by the Commission in such manner specified at **Appendix III**.
- c. Provided that in case the Commission decides not to grant recognition to any qualification, the Commission shall give a reasonable opportunity of being heard to such authority before refusing to grant such recognition.
- d. Where the Commission refuses to grant recognition to a medical qualification under sub-section (2), the authority concerned may prefer an appeal to the Central Government for grant of recognition.
- e. Notification of recognition of qualification by Commission shall be on quarterly basis.
- f. All qualifications which have been recognised before the date of commencement of this Act and are included in the Third Schedule to the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 shall also be recognised medical qualifications for the purposes of this Act and shall be listed and maintained by the Commission in such manner as may be specified by regulations.
- g. Any person with a foreign medical qualification shall have to qualify National Exit Test for the purpose of obtaining licence to practice Homoeopathy as

medical practitioner of Homoeopathy and for enrolment in the State Register or the National Register, as the case may be, in such manner as may be specified by regulations.

5.3. The requisite criteria for grant of recognition to qualification awarded/granted by universities or medical institutions outside India shall be as defined as below:

- a. Copy of relevant ordinance/regulations/rules of state or Country applicable for conducting Homoeopathy undergraduate or postgraduate course in Homoeopathy.
- b. Copy of relevant ordinance/regulations/rules of the University applicable for conducting Homoeopathy undergraduate or postgraduate course in Homoeopathy.
- c. Number of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges affiliated to University, at present (and in past) (with their names & addresses and intake capacity).
- d. Details of hospital staff in Teaching Homoeopathic Hospitals attached to such college as per Homoeopathy Regulations applicable to state or Country.
- e. Details of year wise subjects taught to under graduate / post graduate students.
- f. Details of subject wise curriculum to under graduate / post graduate students.
- g. Details of examination scheme followed for under graduate / post graduate examination.
- h. Details of qualification of examiners (internal & external) for under graduate / post graduate examination.
- i. Details of qualifications of teachers defined at the time of appointment of teachers in various cadres.
- j. Details of undergraduate students (name, date of admission to college, date of internship joining, date of internship completion) and post graduate students (name, date of admission, date of first examination, date of second part examination, date of result).
- k. Details of essential infrastructure available in college & hospital for teaching & training of under graduate / post graduate students.
- l. Details of computer, library & laboratory facilities in college for under graduate / postgraduate students.
- m. Any other relevant information pertaining to college permission, university affiliation etc.

5.4 The recognition so granted to undergraduate & postgraduate qualification awarded/granted by universities or medical institutions outside India shall be for a period of two years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

5.5. The procedure for renewal of recognition of qualification awarded/granted by universities or medical institutions outside India shall be as defined by NCH

under 5.2.

5.5.1 At the time of renewal institute shall provide the requisite documents as mentioned in 5.3 whichever applicable for an eligible batch of undergraduate / postgraduate courses.

5.5.2 The procedure for renewal of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

6. Criteria for Grant of Recognition of Qualification

- a. Due permission for admission into said degree by erstwhile CCH, presently NCH.
- b. Duration of the course is as defined by erstwhile CCH, presently NCH.
- c. Syllabus/Curriculum adopted is as specified by erstwhile CCH, presently NCH.
- d. Evaluation system is as defined by erstwhile CCH, presently NCH.
- e. Nomenclature of degree as specified by erstwhile CCH, presently NCH.

7. Withdrawal of recognition or de-recognition of qualification: Once the Commission is of the opinion to withdraw or de-recognize the qualification as per section 37 of NCH 2020, the HEB shall notify as per Table-2 or 3 and DRL-1 or 2 shall be amended accordingly.

7.1 Procedure

- a. Where, upon a report received from the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy or otherwise, it appears to the Commission that—
 - i. the courses of study and examination to be undergone in, or the proficiency required from candidates at any examination held by, a University or medical institution do not conform to the standards specified by Homoeopathy Education Board; or
 - ii. the standards and norms for infrastructure, faculty and quality of education in medical institutions as determined by the Homoeopathy Education Board are not adhered to by any University or medical institution, and such University or medical institution has failed to take necessary corrective action to maintain specified minimum standards, the Commission may initiate action in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of NCH Act 2020
- b. Provided that the Commission shall, before, taking any action for *suo motu* withdrawal of recognition granted to the medical qualification awarded by a University or medical institution, impose penalty in accordance with the provisions of clause (f) of sub-section (1) of section 28 of NCH Act 2020.
- c. The Commission shall, after making such further inquiry as it deems fit, and after holding consultations with the State Government and the

authority of the concerned University or medical institution, comes to the conclusion that the recognition granted to a medical qualification ought to be withdrawn, it may, by order, withdraw recognition granted to such medical qualification and direct the Homoeopathy Education Board to amend the entries against the University or medical institution concerned in the list maintained by that Board to the effect that the recognition granted to such qualification is withdrawn with effect from the date specified in that order.

- d. If the Commission, after verification with the authority in any country outside India, is of the opinion that a recognised medical qualification which is included in the list maintained by it is to be de-recognised, it may, by order, de-recognise such medical qualification and remove it from the list maintained by the Commission with effect from the date of such order.

8. Once the degree granted recognition/included under section 4 and 5 above shall maintain the list of the same, specialty wise in separate registers as per the (Appendix-II & III)

9. SEQUENCE CODE

As per the erstwhile CCH Act, the qualifications/degrees are recognised/included under Schedule-II. As the erstwhile CCH has been repealed, the degrees/qualifications included under Schedule-II of HCC Act 1973 shall be maintained and the qualifications included in Schedule- II as 'Onwards' basis shall be read as 'up to June 2022'. These universities shall reapply as per section 4 and 5 of this regulation within 45 days of completion of UG internship/ PG Course of an eligible batch.

- a. The NCH Act provides the provision of recognizing the qualifications/degrees under section 35 & 36. Hence a new system shall be started.
- b. The new pattern of coding of sequence of degree recognition shall be as follows:
 - i. For coding pattern , State, University, College, year of grant of recognition followed by qualification (as per Appendix II, III) and amendments if any.
 - ii. State: State in which university is located. State is abbreviated as per standard abbreviations. (**Appendix-IV**).
 - iii. University: University codes as allotted by NCH are stated as per **Appendix-V**.
 - iv. College: College code as allotted by NCH are stated as per **Appendix-VI**
 - v. Year: Calendar Year of grant of recognition will be taken as it is & update time to time.
 - vi. Qualification: Qualifications that are granted recognition in Section-35 & Section 36 shall be coded as under (**Table-1**).
