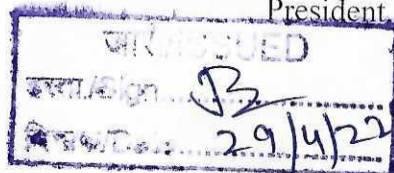

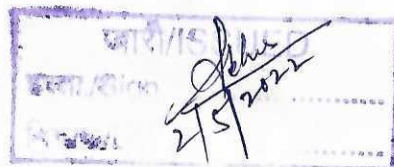

In the advertisement published by you, it is found that your college is inviting students/aspirants for admissions by the using the following words/phrases-

"Direct Admission (priority to NEET Appeared Students)"

A copy of your advertisement (as got from social media) is enclosed.

From the advertisement as published by you, it appears that your college is giving direct admissions to such candidates/students/aspirants who are not qualified in NEET which is against the rules and regulations of the Commission. Any admission which is not as per norms/rules/regulations as prescribed in the Homoeopathy (Degree Course) B.H.M.S. (Hom) Regulations, 1983 (as amended from time) are void. Such misleading and deceptive advertisements are also liable for criminal prosecution.

In view of the above, you are to show cause as to why action should not be initiated against your institution/college for deceitful/misleading advertisements and as to why permissions for B.H.M.S. Courses for the academic year 2021-22 and subsequent years should not be cancelled/revoked.

Your reply should reach to the Commission within seven days from the date of the receipt of the letter.
