Sub:-Modification of upper age limit-information bulletin –Homoeopathy courses- NEET- UG 2022-reg.


Sir,

With reference to subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that National Commission for Homoeopathy in accordance to the letter no L-14030/70/2022-EP-I dated 14.07.2022 received from M/o Ayush and in compliance to judgment order dated 19.04.2022 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India with regards to upper age limit for candidates appearing the NEET-UG examination for admission in Homoeopathy courses.

With due approval of Competent Authority it is decided to modify upper age limit for candidates appearing the NEET-UG examination for admissions in Homoeopathy courses from the A.Y 2022-23 onwards.

Accordingly, you are hereby requested to modify in respect of upper age limit in the information bulletin pertaining to Homoeopathy courses(BHMS) of NEET-UG 2022, in the chapter '16' [at 16.01.1(c)].

Sub: Removal of Upper age limit for candidates appearing in NEET-UG examination for admission in ASU&H (BAMS/BSMS/BUMS/BHMS) Undergraduate course from the A.Y 2022-23 onwards, in compliance of the Judgment Order dated 19.04.2022 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India - reg.

Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to refer to the following Regulations:

- i. NCIMS-Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education Regulations-2022 (sub-regulation 1(b) of Regulation 5)
- ii. NCISM-Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Siddha Education Regulations-2022 (sub-regulation 1(d) of Regulation 4)
- iii. NCISM-Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education Regulations-2022 (sub-regulation ii(e) of Regulation 4)
- iv. The Homoeopathy (Degree Course) Amendment Regulations, 2018 (sub-regulation ii (b) of Regulation 4)

In the above said Regulations, wherein, with regards to upper age limit for candidates appearing in NEET-UG examination for admission to ASU&H -UG(BAMS/BSMS/ BUMS/ BHMS) courses; the following provisions has been made: *"No candidates shall be admitted to UG Degree Programme unless the candidate attained the age of seventeen years on or before the 31st December of the year of admission in the first year of the programme and not more than twenty-five years on the 31st December of the year of admission in the first year of the programme"*

2. In this regard, it is stated that The National Medical Council (NMC), in its meeting held on 21.10.2021, has decided not to insist on any upper age limit for candidates appearing in NEET-UG Examination and the decision was apprised to the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Based on the decision of the NMC conveyed, the Hon'ble Apex Court has settled the issue in the Special Leave to Appeal(C) No.14320/2018 and the same was disposed of, vide Judgment

Order dated 19.04.2022, with following directions.

"The issue that arises for consideration in these special leave Petitions pertains to the upper age limit fixed for candidates appearing in NEET UG Examination. In view of the decision taken by the National Medical Council, in its meeting held on 22.10.2021, to not insist on any upper age limit for candidates appearing in NEET UG Examination, the lis in these petitions does not survive. The special leave petitions are, accordingly, disposed of. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of." (copy enclosed)

3. Since the admissions to ASU&H-UG courses is also made from the common entrance test called NEET-UG examination, hence, it is imperative that the provision with regard to upper age limit in the relevant regulations of AYUSH is made in accordance with the aforesaid Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

4. In view of the above, in compliance of the judgment order dated 19.04.2022 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the NCISM and NCH are requested to make necessary amendments in the respective Regulations with regards to upper age limit for candidates appearing the NEET-UG examination for admission in ASU&H (BAMS/BSMS/BUMS/BHMS) Undergraduate course from the A.Y 2022-23 onwards.

5. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
